## Affected Product(s)

ICX35-HWC for Verizon

## **Problem Description**

Verizon has confirmed that communication between two SIM cards, that have consecutive IP addresses, will not be able to communicate directly with each other. For example, a SIM card with an IP address of 166.133.133.13, will not be able to communicate with another SIM that has IP address 166.133.133.14. Using this example, .14 cannot communicate with .15, and .13 cannot communicate with .12.

## **Problem Resolution**

Verizon is working on a document that explains this. For now, the simplest way to resolve this is to contact the Verizon representative for the respective SIM cards, and ask for a different IP address.
